ABOUT REACH OUT AND READ COLORADO

Reach Out and Read Colorado is a nonprofit organization that works to give young children a foundation for success by incorporating books into pediatric care and encouraging families to read aloud together.

How do we do this?

Reach Out and Read Colorado empowers health care providers to talk with parents of young children about the importance of reading aloud at health check-ups with a special focus on children growing up in poverty. By building on the unique relationship between parents and health care providers, Reach Out and Read Colorado helps families and communities encourage early literacy skills so children enter school prepared for success.

Reach Out and Read Colorado's model is made up of three components:

- 1) a brand new, developmentally- and language-appropriate book,
- 2) anticipatory guidance discussed by a health care provider and
- 3) a literacy-rich clinic environment. This third component begins in the waiting room, where we encourage all clinics to have a supply of gently used books available for children to take home.

Component number 3 is where you come in!

Gently used books will be placed in the clinic waiting room and/or exam rooms. Children and their families can read books while waiting for a visit and should be encouraged to take a book home with them. Books are available for *all* children, including siblings.

Gently Used Book Drive: Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS REACH OUT AND READ COLORADO'S GENTLY USED BOOKS PROGRAM?

Reach Out and Read Colorado's model is made up of three components: 1) a brand new, developmentally- and language-appropriate book, 2) anticipatory guidance discussed by a health care provider and 3) a literacy-rich clinic environment. This third component begins in the waiting room, where we encourage all clinics to have a supply of gently used books available for children to take home.

HOW DO OUR CLINICS USE GENTLY USED BOOKS?

Gently used books will be placed in the clinic waiting room and/or exam rooms. Children and their families can read books while waiting for a visit and should be encouraged to take a book home with them. Books are available for all children, including siblings.

WHAT WILL I NEED TO SET UP A GENTLY USED BOOK DRIVE?

- Bins or boxes to collect books
 You can order boxes that are great for book drives here: www.keeptidy.com
- Signage for the book drive with the Reach Out and Read Colorado logo
- A way to tell people about your book drive!
 A high-trafficked, visible location, social media platforms, emails and posters are all great ways to do this, and Reach Out and Read Colorado would love to share on social media as well.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR GENTLY USED BOOKS?

Gently used books should meet the following criteria:

- New or gently used (covers and pages intact, clean and unmarked pages)
- Age range includes infants through young adults (board books, picture books, early chapter books, young adult novels)
- No textbooks, and no used coloring or activity books
- No books with sensitive themes such as death, religion, divorce or abuse

If you receive books that do not meet these criteria, Reach Out and Read Colorado recommends donating them to a thrift store and/or recycling.

HOW DO I CALCULATE THE # OF BOOKS DONATED?

The best option is to count all the books received. If this isn't possible, an approximation is fine. In general, a small box holds 30-40 books, and a larger box holds 50-60 books.

WHAT DO I DO AFTER THE BOOK DRIVE IS COMPLETE?

After your book drive is complete, please let Reach Out and Read Colorado know. We will ask for an approximate number of books collected, and together we will determine the best method to get the books to the children who need them. Generally books are brought directly to our office, which is located at Martin Luther King Blvd and Colorado Blvd. Depending on the number of boxes and your interest, we could also host a community event where the books are distributed by your employees. This is a great way to see the book donation process come full circle!



Books May Be for the Following Age Groups:

Infants up to and including young adults

No Textbooks

No used coloring or activity books

Gently used books are placed in waiting areas at Reach Out and Read Colorado clinics to create literacy-rich environments, as well as given to siblings accompanying a child at a well-child visit.

"Last spring, we received a donation of children's books from a local high school book drive. The student leader dropped them off at the clinic and as I was emptying the boxes onto the shelf in children's waiting area at least 6 kids came over and pulled a book off the shelf to enjoy while they were waiting. Shortly after that 3 parents came over to read to their children. It was wonderful knowing that just a small upgrade really improved the experience of our patients."
